The project funding was able to sponsor three meetings to coordinate Eastern Brook Trout Joint Venture (EBTJV) partnership actions regarding brook trout habitat restoration and to identify EBTJV project priorities in the three regions (Northern, Southern, Mid-Atlantic). The meetings were held at the most convenient location for all attending to cut down on travel costs. Each meeting engaged most (if not all) partner representatives. Meeting notes and subsequent reporting were sent to the partnership and members. The project provided travel funding for many state participants given their state could not provide funding. The EBTJV website is hosted and updated by CMI funded by this proposal. Updates are made daily, weekly, and as necessary by posting meeting notes, reports, outreach materials, databases, contact information, and links to partner agencies. Eight email listserves were developed to assist subcommittees and working groups to communicate more efficiently and effectively. The EBTJV website was redesigned to accommodate the growth and strength of the partnership. New features include a place for documents, publications, and news releases put out by the outreach committee. A newsletter section has been created and all newsletters from past years to current are now available online. A communication tool for the public or agencies to join the partnership was added in the "Find your Niche" page similar to the NFHP website. Three meetings are planned with the AFS regions to have symposiums and distribute brochures and information about the growing partnership. The brook trout status and threats database has been updated on the website. The Grants and Development Subcommittee has developed a draft long-term funding plan for the partnership and the Working Groups and related Subcommittees are working with this planning phase and future plans for conservation actions.
